## Scale-Up M&E Webinar featuring Educate! and Young1ove

On June 3, <u>Scaling Up Community of Practice (CoP)</u> hosted a webinar on working with NGOs that are collaborating with governments in Africa to scale and sustain innovative and evidence-based education programs. Meghan Mahoney, Director of Monitoring and Evaluation at CoP, highlighted <u>Educate!</u>'s experience tracking the scale and institutionalization of a skills-based education model in Rwanda and the sustainability framework she uses to guide this M&E work. Noam Angrist and Moitshepi Matsheng, co-founders of <u>Younglove</u>, shared their experience working very closely with the Ministry of Education in Botswana to scale the <u>Teaching at the Right Level</u> approach and what they are learning about how to think about and measure institutionalization within government systems. Larry Cooley, Co-Chair of the M&E working group, kicked the session off by sharing an institutionalization tracker he and others have developed to help frame the session.
