SME Initiative Launches New RFP

The Small & Medium Enterprise (SME) Initiative is pleased to announce a **special call for proposals** to its Competitive Research Fund on Entrepreneurship and SME Growth. This request for proposals has a focus on **High-Growth Entrepreneurship in Latin America** and is funded by the **Multilateral Investment Fund of the Inter-American Development Bank (MIF/IDB)**. The objective of this call is to fund studies which will contribute to existing knowledge about fast-growing small and medium enterprises and examine policies that identify and support them. In view of this objective, proposals should focus on "transformationalâ€] rather than subsistence entrepreneurship. Funding will be allocated competitively to projects which address relevant research questions, use rigorous methods, and have the utmost policy relevance in the area of fast-growing businesses in Latin America.

This round of funding is open to all researchers and institutions without restrictions on eligibility.
