## IPA, J-PAL, and the Environmental Law Institute, Present at Geneva Peace Week 2021

On November 3, in a session titled "Emergent Approaches to M&E for Peacebuilding", Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab (J-PAL) Senior Policy Associate <u>Isabela Salgado</u>, IPA's Peace & Recovery Senior Program Associate <u>Daphne Schermer</u>, Environmental Law Institute Research Associate <u>Shehla Chowdhury</u> and Director of Internal Programs Carl Bruch, and the International Development Research Centre (IDRC) Senior Program Officer <u>Martha Mutisi</u> presented on the importance of monitoring and evaluation (M&E) to peacebuilding interventions.
