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## Combatting COVID-19 in Mozambique

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e collected data on individual perceptions of and plans to accept COVID-19 vaccination in Mozambique.

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\*Semple size is approximately 2,075 individuals for Figures 5 and 3,137 for Figure 4, and 130 leaders for Figure 2.

## **KEY FINDINGS**

- 98.3% of individuals intend to get vaccinated against COVID-19.
- Individuals trust the endorsement of their community leaders, with 86.7% of individuals expressing confidence in the vaccination advice of their local
- Households are optimistic about avoiding infection.
   52.7% of individuals believe they are less likely to contract COVID-19 than others in their
- A small percentage (10%) of respondents express vaccine hesitancy. Of these, 41,8% are concerned that vaccines are harmful, and 32,1% have concerns over the possibility of regulary's side effects.
